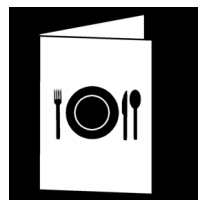
If you have any empty shoe/cereal boxes, could you please send them in to the office by next Wednesday, as Year 6 need them for a project—Thank you!
